PURPOSE

To facilitate adoption and use of its standards and derivative works, the NAAWS Committee, welcomes third party efforts to provide them in as many languages as possible. We rely on the support of others to provide or fund unofficial translations that enable others to understand and implement our standards and/or other derivative works in a responsible manner.

POLICY

The NAAWS Committee, at its sole discretion, may grant permission (in writing and delivered by the NAAWS Committee Secretary) for volunteers to translate or fund the translation of its publications.

Third Party requests shall be submitted in English, in digital (pdf) format on a fully executed request form as referenced above and delivered to the NAAWS Committee Secretary in accordance with the instructions that may also be found on the NAAWS Committee website referenced above.

Requests will be placed on the NAAWS Committee's future meeting agenda and be acted on during their normal course of business as time may allow. The NAAWS Committee is comprised of volunteers and the frequency of their meetings is dependent on current standards activities and their availability to meet.
