General Changes, NAAWS:

- Is based NAAWS 3.0, which was based on AWS 2, including errata for both
- Includes, as appropriate, all AWS 2 suggestions that were deferred to future editions
- Is intended for digital use and includes extensive interactive features
 - Print editions are offered with page tabs and blank alignment pages, however,
 - Page numbering is matched to the digital edition, and
 - All interactive feature controls, being non-functional, are removed
- Adds colorization throughout
- Uses a green shaded header at all compliance requirement pages, and
 - A non-shaded header at all non-compliance requirement pages
- Effective date has been removed from all non-compliance requirement pages
- Adds Page Navigation hot-links buttons for forward, back and previous page movements and jumps to the Sections home page (with its own Content Guide) or the primary Content Guide.
- Adds individual Grade highlighting control buttons within applicable Compliance Requirement Rules tables.
- Adds AWMAC and WI promotional information within the Introductory Information pages of each Section
- Replaces the AWS Design Ideas with a web based DESIGN RESOURCES, including an updated DR icon, URL hotlinks and listing of applicable inclusions in each Section
- Replaces the AWS Table of Contents with an interactive CONTENT GUIDE and
 - The Index with NAAWS's extensive digital search capabilities.
- Adds red text and a new "!" icon to important notices and warnings
- Adds an extensive listing of interactive URL's
